

## **SERVICE OBLIGATION**

Any soldier attending an AMEDD MOSQ Reclassification course incurs a service obligation as stated in the prerequisites listed on ATRRS.

The regulations for USAR and National Guard concerning this are cited below. Soldiers must meet this requirement as a prerequisite. They have until Saturday of the 2nd MUTA-4 to show proof of service remaining just like any other prerequisite, otherwise they are released.

Service remaining is upon completion of the entire course including all its phases.

Soldier enrolling in a TASS course must have the required service remaining by one of the following methods:

- ID card expiration date
- Reenlistment orders
- Extension orders

### **USAR**

#### **(REENLISTMENT)**

IAW AR 140-111 Table 2-3, Line 6. When a soldier is between the ages of 18 and 54 and is required to have a specified term of service remaining after completion of a service school or course and cannot be extended under table 3-1, the member may reenlist any time prior to enrollment in the school or course, or as otherwise required by the school or course (see note 4). The term of service reenlisted for may be the minimum number of whole years required to satisfy the school or course enrollment.

(Note 4) - Reenlistments authorized by this rule will not be processed until officials are assured that the member will-

- a. Be enrolled in the service school or course; or
- b. Qualify for the State tuition assistance program

#### **(EXTENSION)**

IAW AR 140-111 Table 3-1, Rule J. A soldier may be extended to meet the service remaining requirement when selected for attendance at a military school or training course. The soldier may be extended for the period of time to meet the service remaining requirement, but not to exceed 4 years.

### **NATIONAL GUARD**

IAW NGR 351-1, Para 1-10a.

"ARNG personnel attending Army service schools, IRTS, or civilian institutions must have the following time remaining before their mandatory removal date (MRD) or expiration term of service (ETS). Enlisted personnel are not required to extend their reenlistment until after they have been confirmed for enrollment, however, States will not publish orders directing school attendance until the prospective student's ETS

meets or exceeds the standards listed below, exceptions may be granted by CNGB for cogent reasons.

- (1) One year following completion of a school of less than 30 days
- (2) Two years following completion of a school of 31 to 90 days
- (3) Three years following the completion of a school of 91 to 139 days
- (4) Four years following the completion of a school of 140 days or more"
