SUBJECT: Seventh US Army Medical Department (AMEDD) The Army School System (TASS) Conference

1. The Academy of Health Sciences (AHS), US Army Medical Department Center and School (AMEDDC&S) will host the Seventh AMEDD TASS Conference in San Antonio, TX, 1-2 March 2004.
2. The purpose of the conference is to enhance the partnership between the respective Army organizations that comprise TASS. It will be a working forum providing updates on current initiatives, exchange of ideas, and issues related to the TASS program. There will be break out time available for the commanders. The primary goal of the conference is to provide AMEDD guidance and assistance.
3. Invitees include minimal representation from the Division (Institutional Training), Health Service Brigades, Battalions, and Practical Nurse Detachments due to limited space. Additionally, personnel involved in training AMEDD courses in TASS should plan to attend. All AMEDD Title XIs are expected to attend and stay an extra day for Noncommissioned Officer development and quality control procedures.
